Research the life and achievements of Isambard Kingdom Brunel (can be presented on paper, as a Power Point or be creative!) 40 – 80 points	Produce a piece of artwork inspired by William Morris. 30 – 50 points
Design and make a model bridge. 50 – 100 points	Create and write a postcard from a Victorian seaside holiday. 30 – 50 points
Create a Christmas Dinner menu for Queen Victoria and her family. 30 points	Make a model of a Victorian invention. 50 – 100 points
Copy a poem of your choice using your best Victorian copperplate handwriting. 40 points	Create an information poster about a country that used to be part of the British Empire. 30 – 60 points
Create an innovative timeline of key events in the Victorian era. 30 - 60 points	Find out how the pistons are driven on a steam train. Make a working model to demonstrate this system. 50-100 points
